Jesus Heals a Man of Leprosy

When he came down from the mountain, great crowds followed him. And behold, a leper came to him and knelt before him, saying, "Lord, if you will, you can make me clean." And Jesus stretched out his hand and touched him, saying, "I will; be clean." And immediately his leprosy was cleansed.

(Matthew 8:1-3, ESV2011)

Jesus Heals Crowds of People

And he went throughout all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues and proclaiming the gospel of the kingdom and healing every disease and every affliction among the people. So his fame spread throughout all Syria, and they brought him all the sick, those afflicted with various diseases and pains, those oppressed by demons, epileptics, and paralytics, and he healed them.

(Matthew 4:23-24, ESV2011)

Peter and John Meet a Lame Man at the Temple

But Peter said, "I have no silver and gold, but what I do have I give to you. In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, rise up and walk!" And he took him by the right hand and raised him up, and immediately his feet and ankles were made strong. And leaping up he stood and began to walk, and entered the temple with them, walking and leaping and praising God.

(Acts 3:6-8, ESV2011)

Paul at the City of Lystra

Now at Lystra there was a man sitting who could not use his feet. He was crippled from birth and had never walked. He listened to Paul speaking. And Paul, looking intently at him and seeing that he had faith to be made well, said in a loud voice, "Stand upright on your feet." And he sprang up and began walking.

(Acts 14:8-10, ESV2011)

Some Ways People Were Healed In the Bible..

- *Touch / Laying on of Hands – Luke 4:40 – and he laid his hands on every one of them, and healed them.*
- *Anointing with Oil – Mark 6:13 – And they cast out many devils, and anointed with oil many that were sick, and healed [them]*
- *Prayer in Faith – James 5:15 – And the prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up;*
- *Cloths – Acts 19:12 – so that even handkerchiefs and aprons that had touched him were taken to the sick, and their illnesses were cured and the evil spirits left them.*
- *Speaking God's Word – Luke 4:39 – And he (Jesus) stood over her, and rebuked the fever; and it left her: and immediately she arose ...*
